Mark your calendars now for the 32nd Annual Peanut Fest Parade which attracts approximately 200 entries each year. Return your Official Registration Application today as parade space may be limited. Security is provided by the Suffolk Police Department. The parade route is nearly one and one-half miles from start to finish and we expect attendance to exceed 50,000.

Performance locations have been eliminated in order to facilitate parade movement throughout the route. Previous parade judges have indicated they prefer you begin your performance prior to turning onto Main Street from West Washington. This should improve our crowd control, as well as allow for fairness and consistency in our judging process. **Stopping may cause disqualification.** The theme for the 2009 Peanut Fest will be "Nutty about the Light that Shines on Suffolk". In order to assist you with the planning of your entry, you may use the theme or any peanut related idea to create your float or entry. The 32nd Annual Peanut Fest will be held at the Suffolk Executive Airport Thursday, October 8 - Sunday, October 11. Please include this event on your calendar. We look forward to your participation in the 2009 Peanut Fest Parade.

Release and Waiver: In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way in The Suffolk Peanut Fest Parade, I for myself, my heirs, personal representatives or assigns, do **hereby release, waive, and forever discharge** Suffolk Festivals, Inc., it's Board members, staff and volunteers, the City of Suffolk, its Council members, officers, employees, and agents for liability from any and all claims, demands, rights and causes of action of whatever kind resulting in, but not limited to, bodily injury, personal injury, accident or illness (including death), and property damage sustained by me and my agents, representatives, employees, or family members arising from participation in The Suffolk Peanut Fest Parade.

Indemnification: I shall indemnify and hold harmless Suffolk Festivals, Inc., it's Board members, staff and volunteers, the City of Suffolk, its Council members, officers, employees, and agents from and against any and all claims, losses, damages, fines, penalties, suits and costs, including injury and death penalties imposed by any authority which arise out of any violation of law by, and all acts and omissions caused by me, my employees, subcontractors, agents, or representatives during the participation in The Suffolk Peanut Fest Parade.
